
Official Opening Monday 8th September 1975 by Ted Bonner.

This is John Behan's second one-man exhibition in this gallery. He has gone from strength to strength in the two years since his last show, so that around us here we see a greater maturity, a greater versatility, and a thorough knowledge and command of his materials. Many things have happened to John in the last two years, his foundry in Dublin has become internationally famous, he has been elected to the National Arts Council, he had a very successful exhibition in the Sean Desmond Gallery in New York, and he has had two further one-man shows in Dublin.

He is now one of the major artists living and working in this country, and yet he is only on the threshold of a most important career.

John was born in 1938, the eldest of seven children. He is married with three children. He has studied in the National College of Art, in London, Oslo, and under Bernard Coen. In 1970 he and Peter O'Brien set up the Dublin Art Foundry.

Bronze bulls have become a feature of any John Behan show, and this is no exception. They show an extraordinary ramping energy and virility.




Prior to taking up that appointment some years ago, he travelled widely to what he himself describes as the four corners of the circular globe.
