



Sculpture for Galway

Galway City Council, in association with the Kenny Gallery, wish to announce a competition inviting Irish Artists and Artists resident in Ireland to submit ideas for a “SCULPTURE FOR GALWAY”.

Entries suggesting potential public sculpture for different parts of the city may take the form of sculptural maquettes, sketches, visualisations or other suitable media. A selection of the entries submitted will form an exhibition which will take place in the Kenny Gallery in Liosbán, Tuam Road, Galway, to be held in August-September 2016.

A panel of adjudicators - to include a professional artist - will select five leading entries, each of whom will be awarded € 500 to develop their ideas further. This will be followed by further consultation with Galway City Council and Kenny Gallery and will lead to the commission of at least one proposal as a public work.

Entries may be commemorative, memorial, celebratory, functional, decorative, provocative, emotive, emblematic, symbolic, conceptual, but they should all be specific to and for the City of Galway. They may relate to a particular place - The Claddagh, The Promenade, The Market; to writers, sportspeople, musicians, participants in the 1916 Rising or the War of Independence; The Famine ; Theatre; Oysters, Horse Racing, etc...

HOW TO APPLY?

Submission deadline: Saturday 23 July, 2016

The Kenny Gallery will acknowledge the receipt of all applications.

Artists will be notified by 30 July 2016 - unfortunately we are unable to provide individual feedback for unsuccessful candidates.

All those selected for exhibition must then deliver work suitable for exhibition – in sculptural maquette, sketches, visualisations or other suitable media - no later than Saturday 13 August.

The exhibition will open on Friday 26 August.

Is féidir na h-iarrataisí bheith i bhfoirm maquettes, líníochtaí, léir shamhluithe nó meáin oiriúnacha eile. Eagróidh Dánlann Uí Chionnaith (The Kenny Gallery) taispeántas ar bun i Liosbán ar Bhóthar Thuama i Mí Lúnasa-Meán Fomhar 2016 do rogha na n-iarrataisí.

Roghnóidh na moltoirí, ealaíontóir gairmiúil ar dhuine acu, cúig iarrathóirí agus bronnfar 500 euro an duine ortha chun a gcuid smaintí a fhorbairt, agus tar éis tuile comhairle le Comhairle Cathrach na Gaillimhe agus na moltoirí, beidh ar a laghad iarratas amháin tofa mar dhealbh poiblí.
